






ASU Public Events' 1998-99 season "Untold Stories," is dedicated to stories which connect communities by helping us to see each other and ourselves from new perspectives.

Highly Classified: Narratives of ASU's Classified Staff is presented as part of a season full of activities which will culminate in ASU Public Events' Untold Stories Festival: Celebrating Campus and Community, at Gammage Auditorium, April 9-11, 1999. In addition to working on the production of Highly Classified, Roadside Theater is working locally with the ASU Department of Public Safety, Phoenix Metropolitan Boys and Girls Club, and Phoenix Theater's Cookie Company.
