Statistics

- New Mexico state-ran and operated facilities no longer accepts kickbacks/commissions. We are one of eight states. (It is unclear as to whether the four private prisons in New Mexico are in compliance).
- A new contract was just passed for state-operated prisons.
 It is now between \$.59 (party prepaid call) and \$.69 (inmate prepaid and collect calls). International calls are now \$5.00 per 20 minute call. These are flat rate prices for a call up to 20 minutes. There are no longer activation or connect fees.
- There are no federal protections for youth held in adult prisons.
 - o The Federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act do not apply to youth incarcerated in prisons.
- The sentencing of youth to adult prisons has not resulted in a reduction in crime.
